

Obtaining Status Updates for "In Process"

- LA Definition
 - Fail on NHS
 - Had at least 1 follow-up service
 - Inconclusive results for diagnosis
- ▶ Average 2011 2013 = 6.9%
- Conducted 3 related PDSAs
 - Audiologists
 - PCPs
 - Families
- Births Jan June 2014
- Baseline data obtained Aug 2014
- In Process within same facility



PDSA Cycles



Cycle 3: Fax & Email Scan to 4 audiologists for 24 babies

Cycle 2: Fax & Email Scan to 2 audiologists sent by LA EHDI Audiologist for 8 babies




Cycle 1: Fax to 2 audiologists of last follow-up report requesting updated status for 9 babies sent by Follow-up Coordinator

Cycle 1

n=9

Study

- 1 of 2 audiologists responded
- Status update received 5/9 babies



Act

- Adapt with 2 new audiologists
- Sent by LA EHDI Audiologist
- Sent both fax & email scan



Cycle 2

Study

 2/2 audiologists responded



n = 8

▶ Act

- Adapt with 4 new audiologists
- Sent by LA EHDI Audiologist
- Sent both fax & email scan




Cycle 3

Study

- 4/4 audiologists responded
- Status update received on 24/24 babies


Act

- Adopt & Spread
- Improve timeliness receiving LTF reports
- Sustainability

Time Intense

- Develop provider self-monitoring?
- Use LA EHDI-IS & other resources?
- Need to improve timeliness

Provider Education

- Tend to keep baby "in process" too long
- Provide webinar trainings
- TA with LA EHDI Audiologist
- Use specific child cases in education
 - Facility to facility
 - Specific cases have IMPACT!!!

- Number of follow-up services
- Time between follow-up services
