

Early Intervention for Children with Hearing Impairment: From A to Z

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FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2011

This course is designed for teachers, speechlanguage pathologists and early childhood specialists who work with children who are deaf and hard of hearing, age birth-3. Providers will find this workshop to be a general overview of best practices in early intervention in deaf education. Participants will discuss strategies to aid in their practice of coaching families through routinebased experiences and help them maximize communicative interactions with their children.

Participants will be able to summarize the process from referral to services, describe appropriate services for a young child with hearing impairment, understand audiologic test results and their significance regarding a child's access to sound, identify and give examples of resources available to work with young children with hearing impairment, discuss services included in individual sessions and small group instruction and navigate the transition from Part C to Part B.
