Meeting Purpose

The purpose of 2022 virtual EHDI Coordinator Meeting is to help EHDI Coordinators share information and experiences, learn about important updates from federal partners, and hear about new and revised tools geared to help EHDI Programs attain their program goals and objectives.

Meeting Objectives

- 1. Become better acquainted with other EHDI Coordinators and parent leaders.
- 2. Learn how to implement new or revised standardized tools/programs that assist with screening, diagnosis, and parent support.
- 3. Develop a draft work plan, in teams of coordinators and parent leaders, that supports parent engagement at the time of screening, diagnosis, and/or parent to parent support using the presented tools/programs.

Meeting Attendance and Description

All state/territory EHDI Coordinators (or designee) are invited to attend. Please invite a parent leader who has ongoing responsibilities for implementing shared EHDI family engagement and support activities. We anticipate two participants per state. All participants must <u>register</u> to attend the coordinator meeting.

The recent pandemic showed the strength that EHDI programs have to pivot and leverage resources while sustaining the focus on the families served within their state/territory. As an essential service, many programs were challenged to sustain a high-quality program that met prepandemic benchmarks with varying, and often diminished resources. Collaboratively, EHDI Coordinators, parent professionals, community-level stakeholders, and the NTRC and FL3 updated, refined, or developed four tools to support the foundation of EHDI and provide solutions for sustainability and quality improvement. Through educational presentations and robust round table discussions, attendees will have the opportunity to learn about and discuss implementation of the Family EHDI data project (FEHDI) development, EHDI-PALS, the Virtual Site Visit (VSV) project and the Newborn Hearing Screening Training Curriculum (NHSTC). These tools are designed to reduce your workload and to help you meet your current grant objectives.
