


WHAT IS THE REGIONAL INFANT HEARING PROGRAM?

The Regional Infant Hearing
Program (RIHP) has a straight
forward mission: To ensure that
families who have children with any
degree of hearing loss receive the
support they need.

Available to families at no cost

- Enables families to feel informed and more confident in making decisions for their child
- Motivates families to be the best advocates for their child
- Individualizes services for each family's needs
- Cooperates with other related programs such as Help Me Grow



The RIHP provides a wide variety of services to families with children 0-3 years of age with a hearing loss.

RIHP has knowledge and experience servicing families and their children who have any degree of hearing loss including:

- · cochlear implant recipients
- · hard of hearing children
- deaf
- hearing loss with visual impairment
- hearing loss with other disabilities



HOW DOES IT WORK?

RIHP provides families with the ongoing support of a SKI*HI and VIISA Certified Parent Advisor.

Deaf Mentor services are available upon the family's request.

Support Includes:

- Home visits as needed
- Complete information on hearing, hearing loss, amplification, assistive listening devices and cochlear implants
- Unbiased information on the wide varieties of communication opportunities available
- Suggestions for building communication, language development and pre-reading skills
- Provide information for families about audiology, speech and language therapy, school programs and community resources in your area
- · Interaction with other families
- Opportunities to interact with the Deaf Community
